

Where do I find my graded papers?

In your student folder. Any graded papers, missed ISN work, paper communication, etc. will be found in your student folder. You should check your student folder every day you are in class to stay up-to-date on your grades and assignments.

Can I leave for lunch?

Only with your parent's permission. There is a space on the application where your parents can choose to give their permission to let you leave for lunch. As long as that is filled out, you are welcome to leave, but you need to be back in class on time. Many students run to either Buck's BBQ or Sonic for lunch, then bring their food back and eat in the classroom.

When can I use the restroom?

Anytime. We are a small facility with only one restroom, which eliminates the need for hall passes/lengthy bathroom breaks between classes. So, feel free to run to the restroom anytime, but please be respectful with your timing - avoid going while the teacher is giving instructions, when we are in the middle of a lab, or during a timed test/activity. Instead, try to take your breaks between classes or if you finish early with an assignment.

Can I bring my cell phone/tablet to class?

Absolutely. We are a technology-friendly school, and you will often need your phone/tablet to check Edmodo, take pictures or videos of notes on the board, compete in a Quizlet race, etc. However, class time is not the time to worry about your streaks on Snapchat or to watch everyone's story on Instagram. You will have breaks in between classes, and you are more than welcome to check your phone then. Remember that we only have class once a week, so every minute counts. (While bringing a phone/tablet to school is helpful, it is not required - I have tablets I can loan out if you need one.)

Am I allowed to miss a class?

Yes. Your parents are your primary teachers and your authority, so if they give you permission to miss class, no problem at all. There may be a time when you are sick, have a family vacation scheduled, or even a youth group/sports event that you just can't miss. However, please have your parents text/email me, so I know they are aware of your absence (and I don't need to call them to send out a search party). Also, if you do miss class, just check Edmodo for your assignments and any announcements.

Can I eat/drink in class?

Yes. Since some students will have quite a few classes back to back, you may want to bring a snack/drink in addition to your lunch. However, be respectful about picking up after yourself and not distracting others (munching on chips during a major test wouldn't be a good idea).

***One final note: please remember that our school is located in a building with many other businesses. We need to be respectful and mindful of this at all times, not just while you are in the classroom, but ESPECIALLY as you are entering/exiting the building and in the parking lot. Remember that you are representatives of the school and also ambassadors for Christ, so I encourage you to go above and beyond to be courteous and helpful to everyone - greet people with a smile, hold a door open for a stranger, take out someone's trash, help someone carry something, etc.. In short, help us make our "neighbors" feel loved and glad we are here.
